Who Can Sign Vital Statistics Application Forms?

- **Birth Certificates:**

- The person who is the subject of the certificate.
- A parent of the person who is subject to the certificate if the subject is less than 19 years of age or incapable.
- A custodial guardian if no parent under (b) is capable (guardianship papers must be provided).
- A person who has written authorization form a person described in (a), (b) or (c) to be issued the certificate.
- An officer of any provincial government or the government of Canada who requires the certificate for use in the discharge of official duties (letter required).
- Any other person who satisfies the Chief Executive Officer concerning the good faith of the person's cause for requiring the certificate (letter required).

If WCTS is submitting the application form, a "Release Document," signed by the solicitor's client (one of (a) to (f)), must accompany the application (faxed copy is acceptable).

- **Marriage Certificates:**

- Either party of the marriage.
- A person who has written authorization of either party to the marriage.
- Any other person who satisfies the Chief Executive Officer concerning the good faith of the person's cause for requiring the certificate (letter required).

If WCTS is submitting the application form, a "Release Document," signed by the solicitor's client (one of (a) to (c)), must accompany the application (faxed copy is acceptable).

- **Wills Searches:**

- Any individual, including an agent, can sign as long as proof of death (death certificate) is included with the request.
- If no death certificate is attached, a solicitor can sign.
- We, as agent, can sign and/or submit an originally signed application as long as a "Release Document," signed by the solicitor accompanies the request.
